EACH STUDENT IS REQUIRED TO READ AT LEAST 2 CHAPTER BOOKS NEAR THEIR LEXILE LEVEL OVER THE SUMMER AND WRITE A 1 PAGE BOOK REPORT ABOUT EACH BOOK. THEY WILL BE DUE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL. INCLUDED ARE SOME RECOMMENDATIONS, BUT THEY ARE ONLY RECOMMENDATIONS. YOU MAY CHOOSE OTHER LEXILE APPROPRIATE BOOKS FOR YOUR CHILD TO READ. It would also be very beneficial to your child to continue going online to any Reading/Lang. Arts resources available.
